## Understanding <sup>the</sup> Ratings

### Recommended

means the candidate received the highest marks compatible with REALTOR® interests.

### Qualified

means the candidate has all the qualities that make them an acceptable candidate, or is in a race where no one candidate stands above another.

### No Position

means a candidate was interviewed and was not given a Recommended or a Qualified ranking.

### Not Interviewed

means the candidate was either unable to appear, chose not to be interviewed or was not offered the chance to interview.

### Declined Interview

means the candidate declined or did not respond to the request for an interview.
