BALLOT REFERENDUMS



VOTE YES ON 1 and 2 in Charleston County

QUESTION 1: Shall Charleston County Council levy a two mill tax in Charleston County to fund a Local Housing Trust Fund to finance affordable housing initiatives operated by Charleston County or jointly operated by the County and other private or governmental entities? Instruction to Voters: All qualified electors desiring to vote in favor of levying a two mill tax shall vote "YES;" and All qualified electors opposed to levying a two mill tax shall vote "NO."

QUESTION 2: Shall Charleston County Council issue not exceeding \$130M of general obligation bonds of Charleston County, payable from the levying of a two mill tax described in Question 1 above, maturing over a period not to exceed twenty (20) years, to fund initiatives as described in Question 1 above? Instruction to Voters: All qualified electors desiring to vote in favor of the issuance of bonds for the stated purpose shall vote "YES;" and All qualified electors opposed to the issuance of bonds for the stated purpose shall vote "NO."

The referendum will allow Charleston County to dedicate a 2 millage increase to bond up to \$130 million dollars for the establishment of the Lowcountry Housing Fund. This seed money is critical for the success of this fund to develop enough housing to meet Charleston County's growing need.

VOTE YES on Charleston County School Improvements

Must a special one percent sales and use tax be imposed in Charleston County for not more than six years with the revenue of the tax used to pay, directly or indirectly, the cost of multiple education capital improvement projects in Charleston County.
